Play-Doh rules!



- 1. Have plenty of shapes. There are ones that are plastic or wooden cut out shapes and others that you could push to make impressions. Each requires a different motor skills.
- 2. Include small and large rollers and plastic scissors. Great tools for building gross motor and getting the "yayas" for wiggly ones.
- 3. Place the play tub where your child can have a clear visual and easy access. Remember their eye line is different than ours. Get on your knees to see their perspective!
- 4. Enjoy the creativity. Make your own shapes to create a storyline; for example, mold a bird and a bird's nest with little eggs, turn a snake into a snail and have him crawl to the Play-Doh snowman, play restaurant and order food and have the chef make Play-Doh pizza and serve you!
